Held in Bloomington, IN, the varsity team will travel by bus to Karst Farm Park on Friday September 4th. After their 1st game, they will be staying at the Comfort Inn in Bedford. Rooms for players/coaches are provided by the booster club. The bus will take the team back to Karst Farm Park for the games on Saturday and then back to Evansville later in the evening. **Riding the bus with the team to and from this event is mandatory.** The game schedule will be provided as soon as possible. The booster club has reserved additional rooms at the hotel for parents.

Race for the Cure

The North Soccer team will meet downtown on Sunday, September 19th and walk the route as a team. We are looking into possibly playing our game against Central as a Race for the Cure game complete with pink t-shirts for jerseys.

Team Dinners

Parents open their homes to the team and provide them with a place to gather and have dinner the night before a game. In the past, some parents have brought dinner to the shelter house @ McCutchanville and served the team dinner there, alleviating any transportation issues.

Transportation to Games

If the game is held in Evansville, it is the player's responsibility to get to the game. If the game is outside of the Evansville area, a bus will take the team from North High School to the game and return them to North High School. If your daughter does not ride the bus home, the coach must have a written note **signed by the parent before the game begins**, indicating your daughter has their own way home.

Tailgate Party

A cookout is planned after the game against Memorial in the Roberts Stadium Parking Lot by Double Cola Fields. This year's party will be September 9, 2009.

Team Pictures –Delivered in about 2 weeks after taken, will be scheduled early in the season.

Orders & payment are due at time of picture taking. Order forms will be given to players the week before. The team pictures will appear in the North Yearbook so you should try to be there even if not purchasing a package.
